Discovery

Oslo Overview & Ski Culture. Admire Oslo's top sites, including the vibrant Aker Brygge Wharf and the Royal Palace, on a scenic drive. In leafy Vigeland Park, stroll to see sculptures by renowned artist Gustav Vigeland. Then, delve into Norway's 4,000-year history of skiing at Holmenkollen and its Ski Museum. From atop this lofty Olympic ski jump, enjoy sweeping views across Oslo.

Norwegian Art & Seafaring. View works by Norway's internationally acclaimed artist Edvard Munch, including "The Scream," at the Munch Museum. Later, learn about the gripping voyages of explorer Thor Heyerdahl at the Kon-Tiki Museum. Finish with a cruise on Oslofjord to behold Oslo from the water!

Bergen Railway. Stunning vistas unfold as you travel to Bergen on Europe's highest altitude railway along one of the world's most scenic train routes. Cross a plateau at more than 4,000 feet above sea level, and pass lovely fjords, waterfalls and emerald forests.

Bergen. Surrounded by seven mountains, cozy Bergen delights with its captivating setting. Tour the historic wharf, Bryggen, a major trading hub for the medieval Hanseatic League. See King Haakon's Hall and other landmarks before visiting the hilltop summer home of revered composer Edvard Grieg.

The Best of Norway. Thrill to one of the world's steepest train rides aboard the Flåm Railway amid Norway's incomparable splendor. Snake past snow-dusted peaks and through mountain tunnels to pristine Aurlandsfjord, a branch of the Sognefjord, Norway's longest fjord. Cruise on this lush waterway to Gudvangen, then relish the Voss district's idyllic landscapes afterward.

Tromsø Overview. During the summer, the sun never sets here, a phenomenon due to Tromsø's position north of the Arctic Circle and the Earth's tilted axis. Discover what this unusual event is like during your stay! Visit the unique Arctic Cathedral and ride a cable car up Floyfjellet Mountain for aweinspiring views of Tromsø and its environs.

Nature & Culture of Northern Norway. Begin with a look at Arctic wildlife at Polaria, featuring an aquarium and playful seals, and then find out what thrives in this climate at a botanical garden. At the Arctic University Museum of Norway, explore the rich culture of the indigenous Sami people with exhibits on reindeer herding, crafts and *joik* music.

Arctic Dogsledding. Learn about sledding and training at a working kennel, then enjoy cuddling with the friendly husky puppies!

Tromsø Fjord Cruise. Revel in the North's majestic coastal scenery and wildlife while cruising along bays, straights and fjords.
