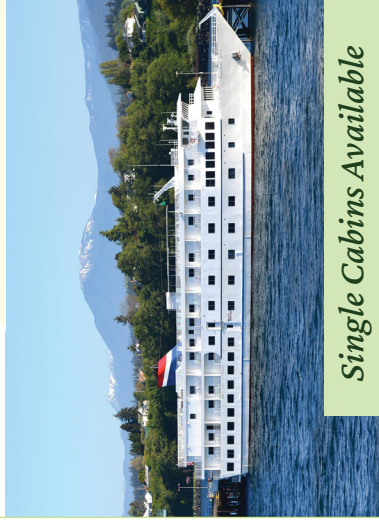

ITINERARY

June 18: Tacoma, Washington - Included Hotel Stay

Ease into your adventure by making your way on your own to an included one-night hotel stay in Tacoma, where waterfront views and mountain backdrops frame one of the Pacific Northwest's most dynamic locations.

June 19: Tacoma, Washington - Embarkation & Begin Cruising Puget Sound

Embark in Tacoma, where Puget Sound meets views of Mount Rainier in the distance. Known for its glass art and maritime heritage, this city offers a striking introduction to your journey.

June 20: Anacortes, Washington

On Fidalgo Island, Anacortes is closely tied to boating culture. Marinas filled with sailboats and fishing vessels, while kayaking routes and coastal trails offer different ways to experience the nearby channels.

June 21: Friday Harbor, Washington

Tucked into San Juan Island, Friday Harbor is known for orca sightings, with dorsal fins sometimes breaking the surface, especially during seasonal migrations. Seals and sea lions can also be seen along the shoreline, while eagles and seabirds circle above.

June 22: Cruising the San Juan Islands / Port Angeles, Washington

Cruise the San Juan Islands, enjoying time on board and the ship's amenities. The journey continues on to Port Angeles at the edge of Olympic National Park.



June 23: Victoria, British Columbia / Port Angeles, Washington

In Victoria, elaborate gardens and well-preserved architecture create a refined setting shaped by British heritage. Across the water, Port Angeles offers a contrast of forested terrain and small-town charm along the coast.

June 24: Port Townsend, Washington

Port Townsend is home to Fort Worden, a former military installation once used to defend Puget Sound. Today, it's bunkers, wide-open fields, and trails overlook the water, offering a different perspective on the town's history.

June 25: Bremerton / Poulsbo, Washington

Poulsbo, often referred to as "Little Norway," reflects its Scandinavian roots in daily life, with Nordic-style architecture, bakeries, and small shops highlighting the town's Norwegian heritage along Liberty Bay.

June 26: Tacoma, Washington- Disembark

Return to Tacoma to disembark, bringing your journey through Puget Sound to a close.

The 90 guest *American Spirit* offers a comfortable exploration along Puget Sound & the San Juan Islands. Its small size allows for travel through the many narrow rivers and shallow bays of the Pacific Northwest. Built in 2005, the ship has all the comforts of home and a casual atmosphere on board. Spacious lounges are gathering points for cocktails, entertainment, or an afternoon lecture with panoramic views of the passing scenery.
